- ✓ **The Basket Bazaar** (basket raffle) - Each class puts together a themed basket which is raffled off at the Fun Fair. **NEW for 2010:** some classes will be combining their resources to create one basket for the raffle. Parents will be asked to contribute items for their class basket and/or make a monetary contribution so your room parent can purchase items.
