

PTA Art Appreciation Program Frequently Asked Questions

Where do I find the art cart with the visual aids and project supplies?

In Room 39 – which is located through the front/main door, take the first left, and it is the first door on the right.

How do I know that the cart will be there at the time I need it for my lesson?

Who do I need to coordinate with in determining a date and time for the lesson?

You should contact the classroom teacher to decide upon a mutually convenient time.

Does the teacher help me with the lesson?
